**Proposed Development at Crystal Palace Park, Thicket Road, London
SE20 8DT**

I GIVE NOTICE THAT London Development Agency is applying to the LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY for permission for Comprehensive phased scheme for landscaping and improvement of Park comprising demolition of and alterations to existing buildings and structures including removal of existing hard surfaces; changes of use including of part of the caravan site to public open space and museum to park rangers base; erection of new building and structures for various uses including museum / park maintenance facilities / community facility / information kiosk / greenhouses / retail kiosks / cafes / toilets / classroom / children's nursery / treetop walk / student accommodation and up to 180 residential dwellings; erection of new regional sports centre including indoor swimming pool; alterations to ground levels with new pedestrian paths / vehicular access / car park / highway works / water features together with associated and ancillary works / plant and equipment and that the development is accompanied by an environmental statement.

The proposed development does not accord with the provisions of the plan in force in the area in which the land to which the application relates is situated. The site falls within the Crystal Palace Park Conservation area, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance.
